Registering for Early SEU Dual Enrollment Classes

Thank you for choosing to do Early SEU dual enrollment courses through Southeastern University's Ohio regional campus. Early SEU students can take online classes from anywhere in Ohio. They can also take some face-to-face SEU Ohio classes at the Marengo, Ohio campus at Heartland Conference Retreat Center or attend class virtually on a Google Meet live stream. The instructions below will help you select the right options to apply for Early SEU classes through SEU Ohio.

Step 1: Apply to SEU

Scroll past the "Online" option and go to Partner Sites Florida and Ohio only.



Select Apply to SEU.

Step 2: General Information

When the admission application opens, select No, I am looking to take college courses while I am in High School.



Step 3: Dual Enrollment Programs—Select your campus location

To designate the SEU Ohio campus and use Ohio College Credit Plus funding, please select "*No, I want to take courses through a partner site.*" This choice still works if you are planning to take only online courses.

Note: If you select "*I want to take my courses fully online,*" your campus designation will *not* be SEU Ohio, and you will *not* be able to use Ohio College Credit Plus funding.
